Like other high schools in Ottawa, Youville is part of **Algonquin College's Dual Credit/Triple Play Program** which allows secondary school students to earn a college credit while completing their Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

Students who participate are enrolled in a college course and attend class once a week for fifteen weeks. Upon successfully completing course requirements, students earn a college credit and a high school credit.
